LOTS OF RIDING GOING ON

Besides "Finish the Ride", club members have been busy riding in several tours: Jeff and Phil did the 2 day, 150 mile "Bike MS: Cactus and Crude, Midland to Post"; yours truly rode the "Tour de Gap" (a paltry 27 miles, but I finished ahead of 30 younger male riders, some a LOT younger); and Ron and Jeff rode in the "White River Road Rally". Tours coming up: August 10th, "Roll for the Cure" in Hobbs; August 17th, "Vernon Burning"; also on August 17th, "Tour de Trykes", Enid, Okla; and, of course, August 24th, "Hotter N' Hell Hundred, Wichita Falls.

RIDE FOR MISSIONS

Richard is planning another "Ride for Missions" to raise money for a scholarship at Wayland. He is planning a 300+ mile ride from Plainview to the Metroplex. This is his third attempt; he completed 183 miles on the try last October before running into really bad weather, and he made 200 miles this June.

A firm date for the ride has not been set but it is planned to start sometime on a Thursday in late September or early October, depending upon the weather forecast.

Richard's plan is to leave from the circle in front of Gates Hall, go through Floydada, then to Ralls, Dickens, Benjamin, Guthrie, Seymour, to the Wayland campus in Wichita Falls, then on to Bowie, Decatur, and finally into Haltom City.

Ron is planning to ride with Richard from Plainview to Wichita Falls to finish a segment of his personal goal of riding from Plainview to all the Wayland campuses.

Richard is inviting club members to join him for part, or all, of the ride. He advises that there will be a support vehicle with food, water, and first aid items, but other riders will need to provide for their own expenses, including any needed transportation back to Plainview.
